



2022 MODIFIED KID PITCH BASEBALL/SOFTBALL PROGRAM INFORMATION

The Oregon Recreation and Jerusalem Township Recreation Departments would like to welcome you and your child to the 2022 modified pitch baseball/softball season.

Program Information: Modified kid pitch baseball/softball is a 2 year program. This is **for kids CURRENTLY in 1st and 2nd grade** for this **2021/2022** school year. This gives the kids more time to work on pitching before transitioning to straight baseball/softball. In this program, the kids pitch until a walk is issued. Then the coach comes in to finish the at bat. No walk is issued.

Registration Information: Registration runs from April 4 and ends on May 2.

The program is open to Oregon residents, Jerusalem Township residents, and non-resident students enrolled in the Oregon Public School System or Cardinal Stritch School for the 2021-2022 school year.

To REGISTER **online** go to www.oregonhiorec.com and click “register”, or on the same website, go to “forms” and print out the registration and return with payment (check payable to Oregon Rec) to our drop box. We are at 5330 Seaman Rd and are in the back of the complex in the building with the blue metal roof. Drop box is beige and located to the right of our outside door.

Registration Fee Information: There is a fee structure on the registration form based on residency and free and reduced lunch program. There is a \$10 late fee if you register after the deadline but before the coaches’ meeting. After the coaches’ meeting, you will be placed on a waiting list. We will look at the teams to see if there is room on a team for your child. If there is room on a team, the late fee will be \$20, and your child will be placed on the team with the least amount of players regardless of school.

Uniform/Equipment Information: Your child will be provided with a uniform shirt and hat. ****If your child needs a different size than originally ordered, you will be responsible for the cost.****

- All players must provide their own helmet. Helmets must meet NOCSAE standards.

Game Information: Games will begin in June and will conclude the end of July. They will be played on Sunday afternoons with one to two practices during the week. There will also be weeknight games to ensure the season is concluded by the end of July.

Coaches’ Meeting Information: The coaches’ meeting will be held on Tuesday, May 10 at 6:45PM in Council Chambers. This is for coaches only. Anyone interested in coaching or assisting should attend this meeting. Parents will be contacted shortly after the coaches’ meeting by your child’s coach.
