



## 2022 T-BALL PROGRAM INFORMATION

The Oregon Recreation and Jerusalem Township Recreation Departments would like to welcome you and your child to the 2022 T-ball season.

**Program Information:** The T-ball program is for one year. This program is **for kids ENTERING kindergarten in the Fall 2022.** \*\*\*\*\***(Kids currently in Kindergarten will play coach pitch baseball/softball.)**

Players will be divided into teams by school districts and will have the opportunity to play approximately 8 – 10 games. Teams will have a volunteer coach who will work with the players to develop their baseball/softball skills, teach them the basics of playing the sport, and to help them to play as a team. Parents are encouraged to become involved and help the coaches with this process.

**Registration Information:** Registration runs from April 4 and ends on May 2.

To REGISTER **online** go to [www.oregonhiorec.com](http://www.oregonhiorec.com) and click “register”, or on the same website, go to “forms” and print out the registration and return with payment (check payable to Oregon Rec) to our drop box. We are at 5330 Seaman Rd and are in the back of the complex in the building with the blue metal roof. Drop box is beige and located to the right of our outside door.

**Registration Fee Information:** There is a fee structure on the registration form based on residency and free and reduced lunch program. There is a \$10 late fee if you register after the deadline but before the coaches’ meeting. After the coaches’ meeting, you will be placed on a waiting list. We will look at the teams to see if there is room on a team for your child. If there is room on a team, the late fee will be \$20, and your child will be placed on the team with the least amount of players regardless of school.

**Uniform/Equipment Information:** Your child will be provided with a uniform shirt and hat. *\*\*\*If your child needs a different size than originally ordered, you will be responsible for the cost.\*\*\**

**Helmets:** All players must provide their own helmet. Helmets must meet NOCSAE standards.

**Game Information:** Games will begin in June and will conclude the end of July. They will be played on Sunday afternoons with one to two practices during the week. There will also be weeknight games to ensure the season is concluded by the end of July.

**Coaches’ Meeting Information:** The coaches’ meeting will be held on Tues. May 10. Time 5:45PM in council chambers! This is for coaches only. Anyone interested in coaching or assisting should attend this meeting. Parents will be contacted shortly after the coaches’ meeting by your child’s coach.

5. By signing this Release, I will be forever prevented from suing or otherwise claiming against the Releasee for any property loss or personal injury that I may sustain while participating in or preparing for the above noted activity.
6. I understand that this Waiver and Release Agreement is binding on me, my spouse, my heirs, my executor, my administrator, personal representatives, and assigns.
