Coach Pitch

1. All batters will be placed in the lineup and a batting order. That order will be followed for the entire game. (***8 pitch max per batter**)
2. An offensive inning will consist of 3 outs or one time through the batting order whichever happens first. The next inning will resume at the top of the order or where the batting order left off.
3. First Half of season 6 strikes = 1 out, 2nd half 3 strikes = 1 out Foul balls = 1 strike
4. Coaches will umpire games.
5. Games will last no longer than 1 hour

Batting

1. A batted ball must travel outside the 5-foot radius of home plate, provided the ball is fair. If the ball does not travel outside the 5-foot radius, it will be declared a foul ball and the batter will bat again.
2. Only one base may be taken on a ball that does not leave the infield. On an outfield hit the player may take as many bases as they would like with the liability of being put out.
3. Bunting is not allowed.

Base Running

1. Base stealing is not allowed.
2. Runners may not take a lead off base before the batter hits the ball. In the event of an infraction, the runner must return to the base occupied before the ball was hit.
3. **Halfway running rules:** if a runner is halfway or more to a base (with the exception of first) when a ball becomes dead, they will be permitted to advance to the next base. If they are not over halfway, they must return to the previous base touched.

Fielding

1. Ball becomes dead when in the possession of an infielder or one attempt has been made on a runner or batter. Halfway running rule applies to the runner.
2. Ball becomes dead if in the pitching circle and in the possession of a player. Halfway running rule applies to the runner.
3. Infielders must not stand in the baseline.
4. All outfielders must be on the outfield grass.
5. Defense will have a child in the pitchers position.

Safety

1. Spectators please keep the area clear between the dugouts behind the backstop for safety purposes.

Coaches

1. Offensive coaches are allowed at 1st and 3rd base, and in the pitching circle, you will also station a coach at the catcher's position.
2. Defensively coaches are allowed behind the fielders, between 1st and 2nd and 2nd and 3rd bases.
